

Lab Technician

Job Summary

Reporting to the Technical Business Director, and based at OSP's Calgary Technical Centre, the Lab Technician will perform an integral role in supporting OSP's technical services laboratory. This position will be responsible for conducting testing in accordance with standard operating procedures, interpreting data, completing client facing reports and ensuring the smooth, safe operation of the Technical Centre. The ideal candidate would have a strong lab acumen with experience in upstream oilfield chemistry and/or oilfield services.

Responsibilities

- Microbial lab testing in support of OSP's LifeCheck service offering. Laboratory tasks will include (training available):
 - ATP testing
 - Microbial DNA testing
 - Biocide efficacy testing
- Preparing client-facing technical reports in a timely and accurate manner
- Maintaining and aiding in the development of standard operating procedures and lab practices
- General lab housekeeping and laboratory information management
- Field work and sampling as required
- Organizing waste disposal for hazardous chemicals and lab samples

Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree in chemistry, engineering, or biological sciences or equivalent experience
- Related experience in the oil and gas industry or as an oilfield lab technician an asset
- Related field experience an asset
- WHMIS, TDG and H₂S Alive training an asset
